Step-by-Step Application Process for International Students

Students may apply directly through the official DTMU admission desk without paying unnecessary consultancy or agent fees.

This document outlines the official step-by-step admission process for students applying to Davit Tvildiani Medical University(DTMU), Georgia. All steps must be followed sequentially to ensure successful admission processing.

1. Initial Application File Submission

Submit CLEAR scanned copies of:

- NEET Scorecard
- 10th & 12th Mark Sheets
- Completed University Application Form [Download Now](#)
- Passport (Mandatory Preferred) or Aadhar Card

All documents must exactly match the details mentioned in the passport. In case of any spelling discrepancies in the name, an affidavit [Download Now](#) confirming the variation will be required.

2. Online Interview - Zoom

A Zoom interview will be scheduled online.

3. University Review & Provisional Admission

Upon academic clearance and successful interview, a Provisional Admission Letter will be issued.

4. Tuition Fee Transfer – Admission Confirmation

Admission is considered CONFIRMED only after tuition fee transfer. First semester tuition fee (USD 3,000) must be paid immediately after receiving the admission letter.

Fee Structure:

Annual tuition Fee: USD 6,000

Tbilisi Campus Accommodation

Accommodation in Tbilisi is arranged through trusted third-party student housing providers. The admission desk will assist students in connecting with these accommodation options

Estimated cost: USD 3,600–4,000 per year depending on the type of accommodation selected.

DTMU RUSTAVI Campus Hostel

Students studying at the Rustavi campus may choose to stay in the official university hostel. The hostel provides 3 meals per day, and accommodation fees are payable per semester.

Room Options:

Room with 4 occupants-350 USD/Month

Room with 3 occupants-400 USD/Month

Room with 2 occupants-500 USD/Month

5. Ministry Approval

After tuition fee transfer:

- University applies for Ministry Accreditation Approval
- Processing time: Approximately 2–3 weeks

6. Pre-Visa Documentation

Applicant must prepare following documents for the visa application process:

- 10th & 12th Mark Sheets - Apostilled
- Sponsor Letter - Apostilled [Download Now](#)
- Sponsor Bank Statement -Last 6-Month
- Health Insurance (Valid in Georgia)
- MOI Certificate (Medium of Instruction)
- Travel Ticket (Dummy Booking)

Additional documents for Applicants under 18 years of age

Students below 18 years must provide the following additional documents for legal compliance:

1. Passports of both Mother & Father / Aadhar copies
2. Parent's consent letter – Apostilled for Georgian Embassy.

3. Power of Attorney for Legal Guardian in Georgia

4. Birth Certificate - Apostilled

7. D3 Study Visa Application – VFS Process

After receiving the official document package from the admission desk, the student will apply for a **D3 Student Visa** through **VFS Global**.

The university will provide the following documents:

- Accommodation Confirmation Letter (Hostel Letter)
- Official Invitation letter Issued by the University
- Rector's Decree confirming admission
- Ministry Approval documents issued by the Government of Georgia

These documents must be submit together with the applicant's personal documents during the VFS visa application process.

8. Travel

After receiving your visa, please send a clear photograph of the **visa page and confirmed flight ticket** to the Admission Desk on WhatsApp immediately.

Students are advised to travel **within 3–4 days after visa approval** to ensure smooth processing of arrival formalities. Airport pickup will be arranged as follows:

- **Tbilisi Campus Students:** Pickup arranged by the hostel accommodation provider.
- **Rustavi Campus Students:** Pickup arranged by the university.

Students will be guided to their accommodation upon arrival.

9. Formalities After Arrival - Bank Account & TRC

After arriving in Georgia, the student must complete several formalities required for residency registration. Within **two days of arrival**, the student will open a **local bank account** with assistance from the Admission Desk.

The student must deposit **USD 2,000** into this account. This amount must remain in the account until the **Temporary Residency Card (TRC)** application is submitted.

The bank will issue an **official balance confirmation letter** verifying the USD 2,000 deposit.

The university will provide the required documents necessary for the **TRC application**.

The student must apply for the **Temporary Residency Card within 15 days of arrival**. Government processing fees for the TRC are approximately **USD 100**.
